This is a high octane thriller which is not for the faint hearted. Fans of Charlie Higson and Darren Shan will love this edge of the seat horror, cringing even as they turn the page.

Charlie is a loner, not through choice but through circumstance. In an effort to forget about his life at home, he joins a sixth form skiing trip to a remote Austrian resort.

Storms are approaching, threatening to cut the town off. Nothing unusual in the mountains, but when the villagers and the

ski guide leave in a hurry, unease begins to run through the party. And, when the teachers disappear, Charlie wonders if he made the right decision to leave Bristol!

As the weather turns into the worst blizzard in years, something begins to stir in the surrounding woods. *Something* is trying to get into the hotel, *something* beyond the students' worst nightmares.

In a horrifying attack, Charlie and the surviving teenagers run for their lives. Helped only by Hanna, the one remaining guide who is harbouring secrets and knowledge of her own, they struggle to deal with the mayhem around them, frantic with almost paralysing fear.
